

MONDAY SCHEDULE

TIME	PLANS
8:45 – 9:00 ARRIVAL	Students will start coming in at about 8:45. School starts at 9:00. The first few students to come in will help pass out morning work books. Check student agendas for their reading from last night. Use a marker to mark it with a simple smiley face.
9:00 – 9:15 MORNING WORK	Students work on morning work page. My morning work book is at the front by my document camera. You can write in my book to check work. Check work at 9:10. Usually after checking work students do a brain break. You can log in to my Gonoodle.com : username: xxxx password: xxxx
9:15 – 9:50 READING	Choose a read aloud and activity from the reading section of my sub tub. You pick! Use as many activities as needed. :)
9:50 – 10:15 READ TO SELF	Read to Self: students should take their book bins and find a quiet spot to read around the room. They should be seated, silent, and reading the entire time.
10:15 – 10:45 WRITING	Choose a writing activity from the writing section of my sub tub. You pick! Use as many activities as needed. :)
10:45 – 11:15 ELA STATIONS	ELA Stations: Students will move their magnet picture to the station they'd like to go to today. Students should work quietly and independently the entire time. Normally I pull small groups, but you will not pull any groups since I am gone. Clean up at 11:15. Most days I have a para that comes to help with stations. If she is available, she might pull a small group OR she might stay and help make sure stations are running smoothly.
11:20 – 11:50 LUNCH	Lunch - please give students hand sanitizer and walk them to the cafeteria. Please DO NOT leave the room with a noisy class in the hallway. They know the hallway expectations, so please don't accept any less than their best. They are very capable of good hallway procedures. Silent, straight, and still. 😊
11:50 – 12:20 RECESS	Pick students up from lunch at 11:50 and walk them back to the classroom. Many students will use the restroom at this time and will meet you back in the classroom. Once everyone is good to go, grab jackets and head outside. My recess bag is black and white and is sitting on the shelf by the door. My radio is on the table behind the door. Please take both outside. In the event that we have indoor recess due to weather, log in to GoNoodle.com , choose the indoor recess channel, and have a movement/dance party. Students may also get on PBS Kids games on their iPad if you still have extra time - I highly suggest the GoNoodle movement recess to get their energy out!
12:30 – 12:40 READ ALOUD	One of the teachers outside with you will blow the whistle at 12:20. As you head inside, send students to the bathroom, hang up coats/jackets, and let them get a drink of water. This usually takes us until about 12:30. At 12:30, call students to the carpet for our chapter book read aloud. This changes frequently, but the book is always located on the easel. Ask Drew or Hailey what our current read aloud is so you know what to grab.
12:40 – 1:25 MATH	Choose a math activity from the math section of my sub tub. You pick! Use as many activities as needed. :)

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1:25 - 2:35 PE & MUSIC	Drop students off at PE at 1:25 for specials. Pick students up from Music at 2:35.
2:40 - 3:30 MATH STATIONS	Students need to finish their math activities you assigned earlier before doing anything else. Once the math activities are finished, students should get their iPads out and complete XtraMath for the day. After they finish XtraMath, they may go to math stations. If they finish that station, they may choose a new one. Students may eat their snack at this time (as long as they are not on their iPads).
3:30 - 3:45 DISMISSAL	<p>At 3:30, clean up math centers. Call students to come get their folders and agendas from the yellow bins. Students should then pack up and meet at the carpet. Please turn on the radio at 3:40 so you can hear any transportation announcements. Car riders/Extended Day are dismissed at 3:45 when the bell rings. Very shortly after, buses will be called over the radio. Students should be at a voice level zero so they can hear buses being called. There is a soft, small basketball in my teacher cabinet that you may pull out for students to play Quiet Ball at the carpet. The rules are that students must be silent. If they talk, they are out. They throw the ball to classmates. If they don't catch the ball, they're out. If they make a bad throw, they're out. The last student standing is the winner. This usually keeps students very quiet for buses. :)</p> <p>Thank you for subbing for me today!</p>

Feel free to pull as many activities, resources, and read alouds needed to help your day run smoothly.

If there is an assembly or a special change in schedule for the day, I will make sure another teacher lets you know. If that happens, please feel free to adjust times outlined above as needed.
